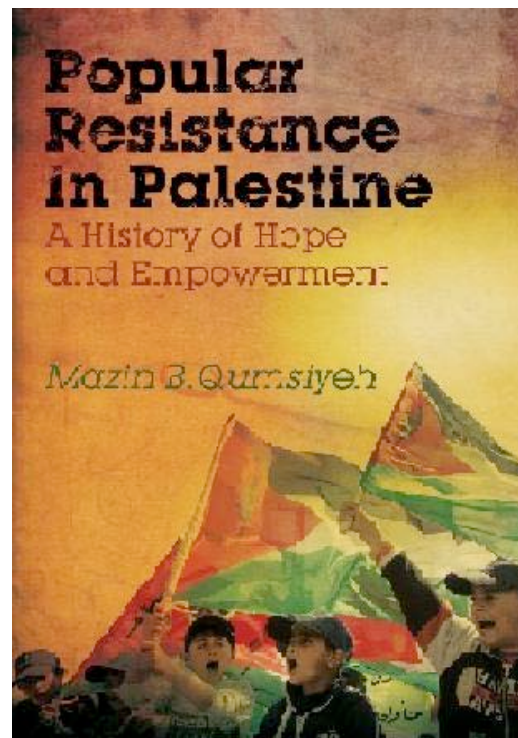


Mazin Qumsiyeh speaks on
